



## Medial Branch Block • C2-3 → single innervation by TON (third occipital nerve) --The superficial medial branch of C3 dorsal ramus --TON, the largest cervical medial branch (1.5 mm) • The deep branch of C3 dorsal ramus → C3 medial branch → join the C4 medial branch to innervate C3-4 facet joint (dual innervation)





## Which View to Choose?

- The short-axis view offers better visualization of blood vessels (from articular processes to neuroforamens)
- The long-axis view better identifies the nerve as a oval shape structure
